Ortega InfoSystems wins pilot IP video security project at Visalia Municipal Airport

Fremont CA – August 15, 2005 -- With funding supplied by the Department of Homeland Security, the Visalia (CA) Municipal Airport authority has chosen Ortega InfoSystems to provide its VideoSmartTM IP Video solution for a pilot security program covering the airport facilities.

Visalia airport (VIS) is a full-service aviation facility providing the air service for the California Central Valley. The airport provides daily scheduled service to Los Angeles, with connections to over 150 destinations throughout the United States. Along with commercial and passenger service, the airport authority has over 150 acres of property available for lease and development on the airport grounds. The City IT management team has been searching for a comprehensive IP-based video surveillance system with an open system architecture for future expansion.
